This is an important issue, not least because the Internet Watch Foundation has found an increase in children abused online are being encouraged to abuse their siblings and friends.</p> <p>Review of sexual abuse in schools and colleges (nspcc.org.uk)</p> <p>This will be a very difficult topic for parents and schools need to tread a very fine line. I think it is probably more useful for primary schools to talk about relationships, how boys and girls are taught to be respectful to each other and how any bullying is tackled (including any online).</p> <p>I think letters to parents should have four aims (maybe a paragraph each):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acknowledge the concerns • Talk about what you are doing about the issue • Offer reassurance that this issue is being taken seriously • Give a positive example of what you have done in the past where issues have arisen (to show confidence that you 'know what you are doing') |
